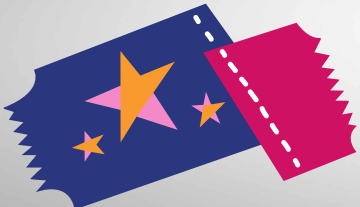

## Costume Packages

### Costume Fee - Due by March 29th 2025

\$85- Class Ages 2-8

\$115- Class Ages 9+

\*\* Price is per costume\*\*

Note: Costume price is determined by the age of the CLASS, not the dancer.

We spend many hours selecting the costumes for each class. They are always age appropriate and high quality. Students will purchase one costume package for each class they would like to perform with.

**The package includes: Costume, Tights, Accessories, and garment bag**

### Recital Fee- Due March 29th

The recital fee is \$80 per family.

It includes a T-shirt for each dancer and a digital link from our professional videographer. The recital fee goes towards production costs such as our beautiful backdrops, stage sets, rental cost of the of the venue, lighting and sound technicians, and janitorial staff.

### Changing Leotards and Tights

One pair of tights is included in your Costume package for each dancer. A changing leotard is **not required**, but can be ordered if needed for your dancer.

### **Orders must be received by March 29th**

Changing Leotard: Child Sizes- \$15 & Adult sizes- \$20

Tights: Child sizes- \$10 Adult sizes- \$12



## **Shoes, Hair, and Makeup**

Be sure that all shoes are cleaned prior to the recital. Shoes are NOT included in your costume package. If you purchase dance shoes just before the recital, please break them in (indoors) so that they are pliable and comfortable for the recital. Students under the age of 12 are not required to wear makeup for the recital, however a little color on the cheeks and lips is recommended due to the bright stage lights. Hairstyles for your specific class are at the discretion of the instructor/choreographer and will be announced before picture day.

## **Tech Rehearsal**

Participation in the tech rehearsal is mandatory. The tech rehearsal allows the students to become familiar with the other dancers on stage, as well as prepare themselves. Tech rehearsal will happen Wednesday and Thursday at Whitney High School theater. Costumes are not necessary for tech rehearsals; dancers should arrive in their class dress code and recital t-shirt.

## **Recital Photography, Videos, and T-Shirts Recital photos**

Expressions Academy partners with Jeannine Bordeaux Photography to provide beautiful keepsake pictures of your child in their costume. Class photos will be taken May 19th - 24th at Expressions Academy during your regular class time. After the group photo shoot, students may choose to have solo portraits made in any or all of their costumes. There is no obligation to purchase photos. Please arrive early or on time for class to ensure we run on time. Hair and makeup should be done as for a performance. If you plan to purchase photos, you must pay a deposit and pre-register with the photographer.

### **Videography**

Expressions Academy partners with the professionals of SpiceRack Productions to record our shows. After recital, you will be emailed a link to download and view.

### **Recital T-shirts**

Included in your recital fee is a commemorative t-shirt for your dancer! These make great keepsakes and we love seeing our dancers wear them to spirit weeks and around the studio.

### **Recital Tickets**

Tickets go on sale Monday, May 19th at 9:00 am. All studio accounts (tuition, costumes, recital fee, etc.) must be paid in full before family members may purchase recital tickets.

For your convenience, EAD utilizes Dance Recital Ticketing and all orders are placed online by each individual family. There is a convenience fee from DRT of \$1.60 on each ticket purchased.

Any extra tickets will be released for open sale on Monday, May 26th.


Cost: \$60 per duo- Includes Adult T-Shirt and 3 rehearsals. (Dancers will wear their costume from their regular class)
